At least one or twice a week, please share and read a book with your child. Please discuss the story with your child. Talk and ask questions about the book, the setting, and different characters within the book.

Encourage your child to talk about their favourite part of they story and get them to explain why they like a certain part.

Book bags to only come into school on Friday so that their 'Sharing Book' can be changed.
