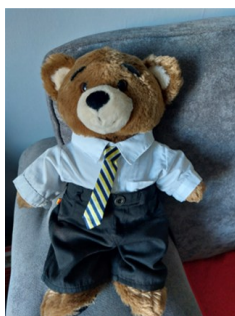


Pre-School Curriculum Newsletter Summer 2
