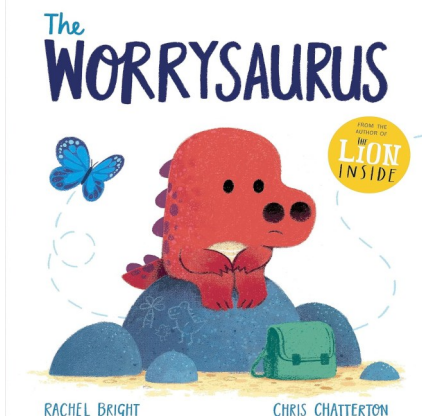
Warmer Weather
