Science

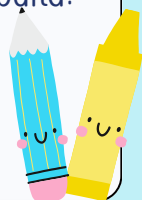
We will be learning about how sounds are created and how humans and other animals can hear them.

Topic

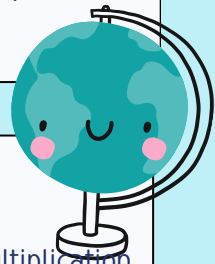
We will be continuing to learn about what life was like in the Anglo Saxon period, and how this has shaped our country throughout history up to today.
