Science

Our topic this term will be' Animals, including humans - Growth' children will learn how to notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. They find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) and finally they learn how to describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

Maths

We will be continuing to work on measurement (time). We will begin working on problem solving including word problems, showing the children how to break down the problem and deciding what they need to do to solve it. The children will also be looking again at the 4 operations and different written methods which they can use to help solve different calculations.

PE

In PE this half term the children will be taking part in Athletics ready for our sports day.
