Maths - Fractions

We will be learning about fractions and focussing on exploring fractions in different representations, for example, fractions of shapes, quantities and fractions on a number line. We will also be learning about equivalent fractions. Later on in the half term, we will move on to learning about decimals.

English—Poetry (Creating images)

In this unit, the children will enjoy a range of poems and discuss and explore their uses of figurative language. They learn and revise metaphor, simile and personification and then identify the features of free verse, haiku and performance poetry. Finally they draft and write their own poems using ones from the unit as models.
