Welcome to our Year 4 children learning at home and to their amazing home teachers. As you will be aware, our home learning is in full swing and we so appreciate your cooperation. Here is what we are learning through Spring 2.

PSHE

As you will be aware, PSHE (Personal, social, health and economic education) is hugely important and will continue over the next half of the Spring Term. The children will learn to recognise the different groups that make up and contribute to a community and identify the people who help the local community.

Maths - We are moving on to focus on multiplication and division. Children will explore multiplication and division, looking first at multiplying and dividing by multiples of 10 and 100, and then at multiplying and dividing by 0 and 1, the understanding

Science - We will be learning all about States of matter. We will be learning about the properties of a solid, liquids and gases and about boiling and freezing points.
