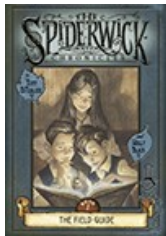

Science - We will be doing to the topic 'Where does all the food go'. In this topic we will be learning about the human body, including the human digestive system and introducing them to the main body parts within the digestive system.

The children will be reading the:



In this unit, the children explore fantasy fiction. They will read the interactive eBook, asking questions and developing understanding of inference. They will use drama to explore characters and suspense, and develop editing and proof-reading skills. At the end of the unit they will be plan, edit and write a new episode of the fantasy story they have studied.
