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Your child should come to school wearing their forest school clothes, children will be supplied with an all-in-one waterproof. They need to wear suitable footwear for indoors. children need to bring wellies in a separate named bag.

No children will be permitted to go to forest school without appropriate clothing that will protect them from extremes of heat or cold, keep them covered to reduce the likelihood of cuts and scrapes and that fits appropriately for comfort. Children and parents are encouraged to think about the usefulness of their clothing for outdoor activities, and to be aware they are likely to take some of our mud home with them after the session. In the forest it can often be cooler than expected under the shade of the trees.

Clothing list:

- ◆ Waterproof coat, with hood
- ◆ Long sleeved top
- ◆ Full length trousers
- ◆ Warm boots (wellies can be very cold during the winter)
- ◆ Warm socks, and a spare pair
- ◆ Gloves and Woolly hat—cold weather
