


Summer Term 2: Minibeasts

This term our topic will be 'Minibeasts'. The children will be learning the names of the different minibeasts, they will be exploring our minibeast hotel and taking part in a variety of minibeast crafts. We will be introducing the story 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' to the children and will be basing activities around this story. During our morning carpet sessions the children will learn their colours as well as numbers 0-3. As part of supporting the children's social skills they will be taking part in adult focused activities such as turn taking, memory games and we will also be encouraging the children to use their imagination during free play, which will also help develop their speech and language skills.
